

JOHN B. & ELIZABETH WIGHT SCHOLARSHIP

Annually, up to two \$8,000 scholarships will be given to a Cairo High School Senior to assist in the pursuit of baccalaureate education and to overcome financial barriers to continued education. Applicants must be a graduating senior from Cairo High School. Applicants must reside in the United States, and be enrolled or intends to enroll in a post secondary college, technical college or university in the United States. Scholarships will be paid \$2,000 a year for up to 4 years and applicants must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of Academics, Leadership Qualities, Extracurricular School Activities, Character, Community Service and Personal Integrity, Financial Need and Prior Work Experience. A transcript must be attached in order to be considered.
