PURPOSE

The Megan Carr, McComb, and Singletary Scholarships are presented annually as financial assistance to graduating senior(s) who plan to pursue a full course of study at a college or university.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants for scholarship awards shall be candidates for graduation from Thomasville High.
- Applicants must have attended Thomasville High for at least two years.
- Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of need, demonstrated ability and desire.
- Applicants must have a cumulative numerical average of **85** or more at the end of the first semester of their senior year.
- SAT and/or ACT scores will be considered.
- Applicants must have been accepted to a public or private college or university that grants a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent.

PROCEDURE

Students who meet the qualifications and wish to apply for a Carr, McComb, and Singletary, Scholarship should:

1. Obtain a scholarship application from a Thomasville High School counselor
2. Contact four persons to complete recommendations (use forms included in application and note requirements on page 4)
3. Complete two required essays
4. Complete all information requested on the application
5. Attach a high school transcript
6. Attach a letter of acceptance from a college or university
7. Turn in completed application to Mrs. West or Mrs. Carter by **April 1st** in order to have it forwarded to the Scholarship Committees.

Announcement of scholarship winner(s) will be made at the Senior Honors Night Program. Payment of funds will be made directly to the student's designated college or university.
